## **Upon Admission**

#### □ Review Your Scholarship Status

Scholarship decisions are announced at the time of admission. To confirm your scholarship status, please log into your **Scholarship Portal**. If you have not been selected, you remain eligible for scholarship consideration should additional funds become available. If selected, you will be notified via email. If you have not already done so, you may apply for any remaining <u>supplemental scholarships</u>.

## □ Financing Options

**Domestic Students:** Apply for federal and/or private loans.

- Federal Loans: Apply for 2025-26 FAFSA using UC Berkeley's school code: 001312.
- Private Loans: Apply with your lender of choice using Berkeley-Haas' code: 001312-75.

International Students: Apply for private loans (with co-signer) or for international loan options not requiring a co-signer.
